Margunn is a Professor at the Faculty of Social Studies, VID Specialized University, and at the Norwegian Centre for Violence and Traumatic Stress Studies in Oslo. She has published widely on Intimate Partner Violence (IPV), men and masculinities, sexual violence, migration, family and gender equality. Her current research is mainly on IPV, mothering and post-separation abuse. Margunn introduced the concept and coined the term for post-separation abuse in Norway.
